PROMPT

- IMPACT How have digital tools allowed people and groups to amplify their messages and mobilize larger audiences?
- PROS AND CONS What are the benefits of reaching a wider audience, facilitating communication, and giving a space for marginalized voices? What are the disadvantages of spreading misinformation and creating the potential of "slacktivism"?
- ANALYSIS Which method, in your opinion is the most effective in achieving tangible change?
